

## **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC PARKS, PLAYGROUNDS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF GRANDVILLE:**

1. The public parks and playgrounds belonging to the City of Grandville shall be open to the public only between the hours of 8:00 am and 11:00 pm of each and every day.
2. The refusal or failure of any person or persons to leave the park system when ordered to do so by the Grandville City Manager, Police Officers, authorized personnel or return to said park system by the person or persons so expelled and/or excluded before the expiration of the period of expulsion and/or exclusion shall be deemed to be a violation of these rules and regulations.
3. No person shall cut, mutilate, injure, overturn, remove, carry away, or in other way damage any personal or real property of whatsoever nature belonging to the park system of the City of Grandville or under its jurisdiction.
4. No person shall use any boisterous, threatening, obscene, profane or indecent language in the park system or cause any unusual noise to be made therein; or engage in any disorderly or indecent conduct; nor shall any intoxicated person be in any such place.
5. No person shall permit any domestic animal to be or run at large within the park system. No dogs shall be permitted in the park system unless on a leash not over eight feet long and in areas permitted and designated by the City Manager. Owner of dogs shall be held responsible for the presence of their dogs in the park system. Any person owning or harboring a dog which is permitted to be in the park system and which shall disturb any birds or animals therein shall be deemed guilty of a violation of the Park Ordinance and these Rules and Regulations.
6. No person shall engage or participate in any gambling, game of chance, or game at which a prize is given for a consideration in the park system; nor shall any person consume or bring into such place any beer, wine, liquor, malt or any other intoxication liquor or controlled substances whatsoever.
7. No person shall post any advertisement, circular or handbill within the park system nor shall any peddler or dealer sell or in any manner dispose of any article in public parks or playgrounds unless he shall first obtain express permission to do so from the City Manager.
8. No permission shall be given to any vendor or peddler of beverages, food or refreshments unless permission is received from the City Manager.
9. No gathering, meetings, banquets or other activities of a political nature shall be permitted in the park system, except at such place therein as shall be designated by the City Manager.
10. Camping, tents, trailer, overnight outings and similar activities are not permitted in the park system.
11. Hunting and trapping of any animal is not permitted in the park system.
12. No fires shall be built in the park system excepting in places provided for that purpose by the park department or as designated and under the direction and control of the City Manager.

GRANDVILLE CITY ORDINANCE NO. 146

Section 9. Penalty. Violation of this Ordinance and the Rules and Regulations shall be a misdemeanor. Any person, firm or corporation who violates, disobeys or neglects or refuses to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance or the Rules and Regulations established there under shall be punished for each offense upon conviction by a fine of not more than \$100.00 and costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the County jail for a period not exceeding ninety days, or by both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
